Allison Wacker's career as a sophomore for Montclair State got off to a great start. In just her second game against Mount St Vincent, she grabbed a goal and an assist in a huge 8-0 victory. She continues to be a strong threat against rival defenders, registering 13 shots in five games.

Defender Becki Krakora continues to prove that she is both a solid defender and a threat at the other end of the field. In her last two games with the Bowdoin Polar Bears, she has held firm to help gift the team with a draw against Bates and a win over Brandeis, with four shots (two on target) in those match-ups.

Following her excellent first-game performance with Wesleyan Cardinals - where she had a goal and an assist in a 2-1 win over Bowdoin College - Laura Kurash has not taken her foot off the gas. The star striker grabbed another goal in her team's 3-0 win over Eastern Connecticut, taking her tally to two goals in the opening three games.

While Villanova have not had the easiest stretch of games in the last few days, Katie Ryan continues to be a threat up front, and is a huge threat to her opponents with seven shots (four on target) in four games. Paired with the excellent Heidi Sabatura of fellow WPSL squad FC Bucks, fans will undoubtedly believe she will grab several more goals as the season progresses.

Julie Campbell, only in her freshman year at Boston College, continues to get named in line-ups with the Eagles, undoubtedly fostering her talent as she gets a taste of D-1 soccer after just months at college.
